AE - 7008 BABY & TODDLER PULLOVER

ORIGINAL GARMENT: 1 - 2 years.

To Fit Ages	3 - 6 months	6 - 12 months	1 - 2 years	3 - 4 years	5 - 6 years
Measurement all Round	56cm	61cm	66cm	71cm	76cm
Length to Back of Neck	36cm	38cm	40cm	42cm	46cm
Sleeve Seam	23cm	24cm	25cm	26cm	30cm

MATERIALS:

2(2,2,3,3) Balls **SOUL HP** 100g Colour - 7269H

2,5mm Knitting needles 3mm Knitting needles Stitch holder 3(3,4,4,4) Buttons

TENSION:

32sts x 42 rows = 10cm over Stocking stitch using 3mm knitting needles.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt - alternate, beg - begin(ning),
cont - continue, dec - decrease, foll follow(ing), inc - increase, k - knit, patt(s) pattern(s), p - purl, rem - remain(ing), rep
- repeat, rev - reverse, (W)S - right(wrong)
side, R(W)SF - right(wrong) side facing,
R(W)SR - right(wrong) side row, RW ribwise, st(s) - stitch(es), st st - stocking,
stitch, tog - together

STITCHES USED:

Double rib pattern:

1st Row: *K2, p2, rep from * to last 2sts, k2. 2nd Row:*P2, k2, rep from * to last 2sts, p2. Rep these 2 rows.

Stocking stitch:

1st Row: RSF, one row k. 2nd Row: WSF, one row p. Rep these 2 rows.

PATTERN:

BACK

Using 2,5mm knitting needles cast on 90(98,106,114,122)sts and work in **double rib patt** for 4cm end with a WSR. Change to 3mm knitting needles and cont straight in st st and when work measures 22(23,24,25,27)cm from beg end with a WSR, **SHAPE RAGLANS:** Cast of 4sts at beg on next 2(4,4,4,4)rows, 3sts at bef of foll 2(0,2,0,0)rows, 2sts at beg of foll 0(2,2,2,2) rows, then dec 1st (= work 2tog) at each end of every foll alt row 26(27,28,31,35) times = 24(24,24,32,32)sts. Cast off rem sts.

FRONT:

Work as for back and when work measures 31(33,35,37,41)cm from beg end a WSR, **SHAPE NECK:** Cont raglan shaping, cast off centre 10(10,10,16,16)sts for neck opening and cont on rem sts for left side of work.

LEFT SIDE: Work one row. Dec 1st (= work 2tog) at beg (neck edge) of next and at same edge of foll alt row 7(8,8,8,8)times AT THE SAME TIME cont raglan shaping as before until 2sts rem, k2tog, fasten off. RIGHT SIDE: WSF, rejoin yarn at neck edge and work as for left side, rev shaping.

SLEEVES (Both alike):

Using 2.5mm knitting needles cast on 54(54,58,62,66)sts and work in **double rib patt** for 3(4,4,4,4)cm end with a RSR. **Next row, inc row:** Work one row on WS, inc 0(0,0,2,2)sts evenly across row = 54(54,58,64,68)sts.

Change to 3mm knitting needles and cont in st st, inc 1st at each end of every foll 4^{th} row 0(5,9,0,0)times, every foll 6^{th} row 4(10,8,12,16)times, then every foll 8^{th} row 7(0,0,2,1)times = 76(84,92,92,102)sts. Cont straight and when work measures 23(24,25,26,30)cm from beg end with a WSR.

SHAPE RAGLANS as for back = 10(10,10,10,12)sts.
Cast off rem sts.

TO MAKE UP:

Sew raglan seams, leaving left front seam open.

NECKBAND: RSF, using 2.5mm knitting needles, pick up and k36(36,36,48,48) sts around neck opening of front 12(12,12,12,14)sts across top of right sleeve 26(26,26,34,34)sts across back of neck and 12(12,12,12,14)sts across top of left sleeve 86(86,86,106,106)sts.

Work in **double rib patt** (beg with p2) for 2(2,3,3,3)cm end with a WSR.

FRONT BUTTONHOLE BAND: RSF, using 2.5mm knitting needles, pick up and k54(58,66,70,78)sts (= 35sts per 10cm)

evenly up left front raglan edge and neckband edge.

Work in **double rib patt** (beg with p2) for 4 rows.

Next row, buttonhole row: Rib 3sts, cast off 3sts, **rib 14(15,12,13,15)sts, cast off 3sts, rep from **1(1,2,2,2)times more in rib 14(16,15,16,18)sts.

Next row: Rib, casting on 3sts over each buttonhole. Cont in **double rib patt** until band measures 3(3,4,4,4)cm end with a WSR, cast off all sts RW.

FRONT BUTTON BAND: RSF, pick up and k54(58,66,70,78)sts evenly down left sleeve and work in **double rib patt** for 3(3,3,4,4,4)cm end with a WSR, cast off all sts RW. Sew bottom edges of front bands tog and sew neatly into place. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. Block garment to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
