



ORIGINAL GARMENT: 81-86cm

To Fit Bust:	81- 86cm	91-97cm	101-107cm	110-117cm
Actual All Round Measurement:	90cm	100cm	110cm	117cm
Length to Shoulder:	74cm	74cm	76cm	76cm

MATERIALS:

7(7;8;8) hanks **INSPIRE** 100g
One pair 10mm knitting needles
Cable Needle
4 buttons
Markers

TENSION:

10 ½ sts to 10cm over stocking stitch using 10mm knitting needle.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt - alternate; **beg** - begin(ning); **cont** - continue; **CN** - cable needle; **dec** - decrease; **k** - knit; **inc** - increase; **patt** - pattern; **p** - purl; **rep** - repeat; **R(W)S** - right(wrong) side; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **gst** - Garter Stitch

STITCHES USED

GARTER STITCH:

Knit every row

STOCKING STITCH:

RS rows: Knit

WS rows: Purl

CABLE PATT: (worked over 8 sts)

C4B - slip next 2 sts onto CN and hold at back of work, k next 2 sts from left hand needle then k sts from CN.

C4F - slip next 2 sts onto CN and hold at front of work, k next 2 sts from left hand needle then k sts from CN.

M1 - Pick up loop lying between the 2 sts and k into back of it (inc. one st)

BACK:

Cast on 50(52;56;60)sts and counting first row as RS row, work 5 rows in gst.

Next row: k9(10;10;12), p32(32;36;36), k9(10;10;12)

Next row: K to end.

Rep last 2 rows until work measures 23(23;25;25)cm from cast on edge ending with a WS row.

Place a marker at both ends of last row.

SHAPE SIDES:

Row 1: k9(10;10;12), M1, k32(32;36;36), M1, k to end.

Row 2: k10(11;11;13), p32(32;36;36), k to

end.

Row 3: K to end.

Row 4: As row 2.

Row 5: K10(11;11;13), M1, k32(32;36;36), M1, k to end.

Row 6: K11(12;12;14), p32(32;36;36) sts, k to end.

Row 7: K to end

Row 8: As row 6.

Cont to inc in the same way in next and every 4th row working inc sts in gst 7(7;8;8) times, then in every 6th row 5 times. 74(76;82;86)sts.

Cont without inc until back measures 74(74;76;76)cm ending with a WS row. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT:

Cast on 28(29;30;32)sts and work 5 rows in gst.

Next row: (WS) K11(11;12;12), p8, k9(10;10;12)

Next row: K to end.

Rep last 2 rows two times more, then 1st row once more.

Start Cable Patt.

Row 1: K9(10;10;11), C4B, C4F, k to end.

Row 2: K11(11;12;12), p8, k to end.

Row 3: K to end.

Rows 4 to 10: Rep rows 2 and 3, 3 times more, then row 2 once more.

Rep from row to 10 throughout for cable patt. **AT THE SAME TIME:** when front matches back to shape side ending with a WS row, work as follows: (place a marker at the end of last row)

Next row: K9(10;10;12), M1, patt to end.

Next row: K11(11;12;12), p8, k to end.

Keeping continuity of Cable, inc 1st at the same edge in every 4th row 7(7;8;8) times, then in every 6th row, 5 times 40((41;43;45) sts.

Work straight until Front matches back to shoulder line, ending with a WS row. Cast off until 11(11;12;12) sts on needle. Cont on gst until collar matches to centre of back neck. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT:

Mark position of buttonholes. First to come 3cm from cast on edge, last at 45cm from

cast off edge and the other 2 evenly spaced.

TO MAKE A BUTTONHOLE:

Row 1: RS. k3, cast off 2 sts, patt to end.

Row 2: Patt to end, casting on 2 sts on top of cast off sts.

Cast on 28(29;30;32)sts and work 5 rows in gst.

Next row: (WS) K9(10;10;12), p8, k11(11;12;12).

Next row: K to end.

Keeping continuity of cable pattern work to match left front, inc 1st after cable in every 4th row 7(7;8;8) times, then in 6th row 5 times.

When Front matches back to shoulder line, ending with a RS row, cast off until 11(11;12;12)sts on needle and complete collar to match left side.

TO MAKE UP:

Join shoulder seams. Join cast off edges of collar and sew at back of neck. Join side seams up to markers. Sew on buttons.



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
