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AE - 6012 LADIES PONCHO

ORIGINAL GARMENT: One size fits all.

MATERIALS:

6 Balls **HOPE** 25g Colour - 6258

4mm Crochet hook 4.5mm Crochet hook

MEASUREMENTS:

Total Width: 80cm (when folded in half). Total Length: 50cm.

TENSION:

17sts x 7rows = 10 x10cm working with a 4.5mm crochet hook and in tr's.

ABBREVIATIONS:

3trtog - two treble together

beg - begin(ing)

ch - chain

chsp(s) - chain space(s)

cont - continue

dc - double crochet

rem - remaining

RS - right side

sk - skip

sl st – slip stitch

st - stitch

tr - treble

WS - wrong side

PATTERN NOTES:

Start each tr row with ch3 (= 1st st) Sew the neckline up to the point where it feels comfortable, at the 'sleeve' edge.

PATTERN:

BODY:

With 4.5mm crochet hook, loosely make 133ch.

1st Row: (RS), Insert hook in 4th ch from hook, make 1tr, work 1tr in each ch across, turn. (=131tr)

2nd Row: Ch5 (= tr, ch2), 1tr at the base of the ch5, *sk 2tr, 1tr in the next 5tr, sk 2tr, (1tr, ch2, 1tr, ch2, 1tr) in next tr,* rep from * to last 11sts, sk 2tr, 1tr in last 5tr, sk 2tr, (1tr, ch2, 1tr) in last st, turn.

3rd Row: Ch2, 1tr in 2chsp, ch2, *1tr in next 5tr, ch2, 3dctog over next (2chsp, tr, 2chsp), ch2*, rep from * to last 2chsp, ch2, 2trtog over last 2chsp and last st, turn.

4th Row: Ch3, 1tr in each st across, turn.

5th Row: Ch3, 1tr in next 2tr, *sk 2tr, (1tr, ch2, 1tr, ch2, 1tr) in next tr, sk 2tr, 1tr in next 5tr*, rep from * to last 8sts, sk 2tr, (1tr, ch2, 1tr, ch2, 1tr) in next tr, sk 2tr, 1tr in last 3sts, turn.

6th Row: Ch3, 1tr in next 2tr, *ch2, 3trtog over next (2chsp, tr, 2chsp), ch2, 1tr in

next 5tr*, rep from * to last 2 2chsps, ch2, with a damp clot 3trtog over next (2chsp, tr, 2chsp), ch2, 1tr and allow to dry. in last 3sts, turn.

7th Row: Rep 4th Row.

Rep 2nd - 7th Row, until a total of 40 rows have been worked. Fasten off.

Fold piece in half, vertically. The next section will be worked on the edges of the rows.

SLEEVE

Using a 4.5mm crochet hook, and with RS facing, join yarn in the first ch of the foundation ch.

1st Row: Ch3, work 2tr around the post of the edge st of the first row of the body, *ch2, sk next row, 3tr around the post of the next edge st*, rep from * all the way across the first section of the body, ch2, sk last edge row and work a tr in the first st of the last row, move over to the next section of the body, work 1tr in the first st of the last row of the back section of the body, *ch2, 3tr around the post of the next edge st, sk next row*, rep from * across, finish with 3tr around the post of the first st of the last row, turn.

2nd Row: Ch3, 1tr in next 2tr, *ch2, sk next 2chsp, 1tr in next 3tr*, rep from * to where the front and back meet, ch2, 1tr between the next 2tr of the neckline, ch2, sk next 2chsp, *1tr in next 3tr, ch2, sk next 2chsp*, rep from * all across, 1tr in last 3tr, turn.

3rd Row: Ch3, 1tr in next 2tr, *ch2, sk next 2chsp, 1tr in next 3tr*, rep from * across, to mid-section, ch2, sk next 2chsp, 1tr in next tr, *ch2, sk next 2chsp, 1tr in next 3tr*, rep from * to end, turn.

Rep 3rd Row until a total of 27 rows is completed. Fasten off.

FINISH UP:

Turn the piece around and with WS facing, sew a section of the neckline together, until it's a comfortable fit.

FDGING

With RS facing, join yarn anywhere around the neckline, using a 4mm crochet hook. Work 1 rnd of evenly spaced dc around the neckline. Close the rnd with a sl st. Rep around the bottom/sleeve edge.

Weave in all rem loose ends.

Block garment to measurement, cover

with a damp cloth (or spray with water) and allow to dry.
